Guided Tours with the Beatles Hairdresser Leslie Cavendish

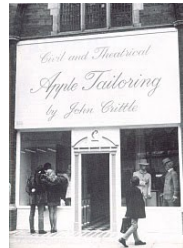

I've put together some sample itineraries which take-in places with particular personal memories, of my time as The Beatles hairdresser, which I will share with you...

The Magical History Tour

- Allsop Place (start of The Magical Mystery Tour)
- The former Apple Shop (Baker Street)
- Registry Office where two Beatles were married
- John and Yoko's Apartment ("Two Virgins" album cover taken - Ringo and Jimmy Hendrix also lived there)
- Asher family home (Paul lived here and wrote with John, "I Want To Hold Your Hand")
- Marylebone Station (opening scenes for Hard Days night filmed here)

There are Places I Remember Tour

- Apple Offices (Savile Row)
- The famous rooftop session -Hells Angels Meeting and all back to my place (Chelsea)
- Paul McCartney's Office MPL
- London Palladium "birthplace of Beatlemania"
- The studio where "Hey Jude" and many more songs-were recorded
- Carnaby Street the heart of "Swinging London"
- Clubs and art gallery where John met Yoko for the first time

- 161 Kings Road Apple Tailoring and Hair Studio
- Granny Takes a Trip Boutique
